The 2009 Peachland High School Rodeo will be part of a Southern BC Circuit along with several other locations throughout the province. The circuit runs fall and spring to coincide with the school year. Communities from Chilliwack in the Fraser Valley to Vernon in the Okanagan, to several Interior towns including Merritt, Kamloops and Williams Lake make up the Southern Circuit.

The Okanagan community will benefit from an event like this because most competitors travel from other areas of the Province and stay for the weekend, spending tourism dollars within the local areas.

This is a family oriented sport for young competitors, grades 9 to 12. Benefits include the responsibility they learn through caring for their animals, as well as the respect, camaraderie and sportsmanship they gain as competitors. These student competitors must also maintain an average or better grade to be eligible to compete. After competing all season, points are tabulated to determine the top 8 competitors from the North and South regions heading to the Provincial Championship Finals Rodeo.
